- Canopy trees reduce the "heat island" effect of development - buildings, pavements, and highways
- Trees offer privacy
- Trees clean the air we breathe, capture carbon and produce oxygen
- Canopy tree root systems reduce soil erosion and stormwater runoff
- Native canopy trees support hundreds of species of birds, mammals and insects
- Trees stimulate and encourage children to play outdoors and discover the wonders of nature

## Doesn't our neighborhood already have plenty of trees?

We are fortunate to live in a neighborhood known for its mature native trees. However, with many older trees being lost or removed, there is an urgent need to plant the next generation of canopy trees. It takes some species up to 40 years to reach canopy size, so the best time to plant a tree is now!

## What types of trees will be offered?

For this pilot program, we will have a variety of mid to large-sized canopy trees for order in September and planting in October. These will include White Oak, several Red Oak species, Red Maple, and Black Gum.

## Why buy a tree through Camelot ReLeaf?

- Install a six-foot ring of mulch around the tree (by Rimble)
- Install deer protection for the trunk

We offer a free site visit to discuss the best place to plant your tree, as well as advice on the best species to plant depending on your site conditions.

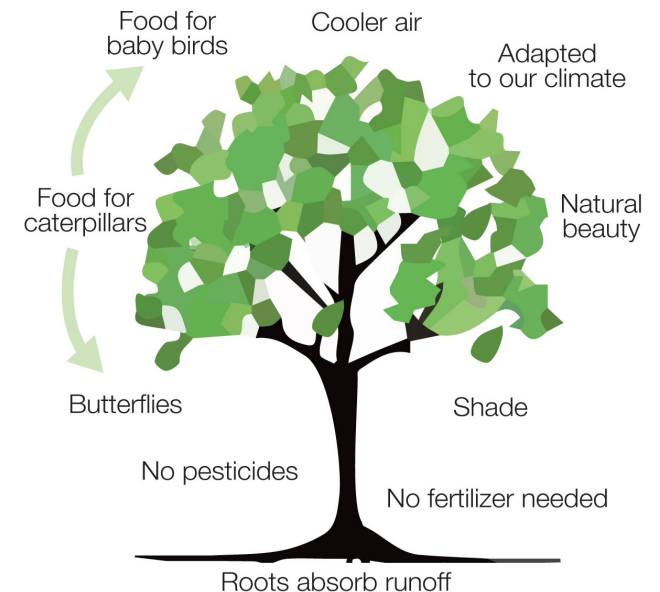
